There will be four to six teams in each league depending on the number of registered youth. Coaches will conduct skill drills and team practices beginning at 6:00 P.M. Games will begin at 6:30 P.M. and be one hour in duration (running time). Colored soccer program T-shirts will be used for uniforms.

The 14-18 yr. olds (also coeducational) program will be more informal, players will not need to register. Their program will consist of drills and scrimmage games each Monday and Wednesday during the month of August. Any youth from the town or village of Potsdam, between 14 and 18 years that has not graduated from high school, is encouraged to participate. This program begins August 4. The group will meet in front of Maxey Hall and go to a designated field from there.

The soccer program is run entirely by volunteers and is in need of parents and

interested citizens for coaching and officiating. Please volunteer so our children can play.

Registration Children may be registered at the rear of the Lawrence Avenue Elementary School, between 6:15-7:30 July 9, 10, 14, 15, 16, and 17 or at the Pine Street Arena Recreation Office. Late registrations will be accepted at the soccer fields for those who were out of town in July or for other exceptional cases. However, please make every effort possible to register in advance so the coaches can be selected and the teams drafted. In order to help youth who cannot afford the registration fee and to train and hire high school or college players for officials, the board of directors is seeking financial assistance. The Northern New York Summer Soccer League has begun its fourth season of play and as has been the case in the past two years, the Potsdam-Morgans booters are off to a fine start. Unbeaten following four contests, the locals added a 3-0 shutout against Star Lake to their previous three wins to stay ahead of Madrid-Waddington (3-1) and Ogdensburg Pepsi (3-1) in league play.

Goalie Dave Dearborn has had plenty of offensive support from the Potsdam-Morgans squad, as the locals have outscored opponents 24-4 so far this year to help him to a fine 1.00 goals against average. Defensively co-captain Pat McGowan is joined by Bill Wass and a trio of former Potsdam High School standouts: John Hartzell, Paul Brown, and Jeff McCasland in the Potsdam-Morgans backfield.


In the midfield slots the arrival of newcomers Ali Ouarzeddini and Steve Middleton have given a new momentum to the line of Luke Awwal, Kennon Fisher, Dan Dumas, and Craig McGowan. Co-captain Frank Signorelli and forwards Salah Noubli, Steve Frank, Scott Howe, and Jamie Newell, give Potsdam-Morgans one of the most respective offensive attacks in the league. Noubli leads the team in scoring with seven goals and two assists, good

for nine points, with Signorelli second at four and six for ten points. Steve Frank (5-2-7), Scott Howe 4-1-5, Jamie Newell (2-4-6), Ali Ouarzeddini (0-4-4), and Kennon Fisher (1-1-3) are the team's other top scorers.


On Wednesday the locals had it all their own way last Wednesday against Star Lake, winning 9-0 behind three goal outings from Sala Noubli, Steve Frank, and Scott Howe. Frank Signorelli, Dave Dearborn, and Kennon Fisher all added single scores, including goalie Dearborn's penalty kick effort. Jamie Newell picked up two assists for Potsdam-Morgans, with Ali Ouarzeddini, and Steve Middleton having oneset-up apiece. The team will be back

in action on July 16 when they travel to Hermon-Dekab for a league match.
